I strongly oppose the proposal to merge the Chaldon and Westway wards for the following reasons. Chaldon is a unique and ancient village surrounded by beautiful areas of countryside, including areas of outstanding natural beauty and scientific interest. This includes protected species, both plants and animals. The Westway ward is polar opposite, with housing continually to the west of London, connectivity by bus routes, run by London transport, a totally different geographically distributed population being primarily a linear village .
