Dear Sir,

I am writing to register my concerns over the proposed new parish council areas.

I understand that there are 3 criteria that need to be satisfied before the new areas are enforced, viz.,

- o All residents are to be fully informed of the proposed changes.
- o The number of residents of voting age should be 3,600 plus or minus 10%.
- o The new proposals should be good fit for the existing community.

In answer to these criteria I would advise that:-

- o No communication has been received by the residents from Shropshire Council.
- o Our existing area meets the criteria of 3,600 plus or minus 10% already, so why change?
- o The proposed link with Cleobury Mortimer is not a good fit with Nash. Cleobury is a small town with totally different demands to Nash, which is a rural environment.

I would also point out that in terms of transport, there is a single road linking us with Burford/Clee Hill, which is 2.5 miles away and takes 3

minutes. The quickest route to Cleobury takes 20 minutes and covers a distance of 8 miles.

Virtually all residents use the facilities at Tenbury Wells (across the bridge from Burford). These include schools, dentists, doctors, hospitals, library, shopping and recreation. It reinforces the link that we have with the existing community and any move to Cleobury would be to the detriment of every adult and child living in Nash.

To change the present arrangements would be foolhardy and totally irrational.

I hope you will reconsider and prevent this bureaucratic farce from taking place.
