Related subject: The physical size of the Derbyshire Dales constituency

Looking at the map of Derbyshire, it is clear to see that Derbyshire Dales is by far the largest constituency by area, running from Hathersage in the north to Doveridge in the south.

In my opinion, the southern boundary of Derbyshire Dales should be Cromford and follow a line west towards Alstonefield. A smaller constituency would be easier to manage and govern, and there would be much more of a sense of place.

The area south of the new southern boundary would need re-naming, perhaps Derwent Valley or Derbyshire Moors, but either way DDDC would have a more focused region to serve.
