To Whom It May Concern

Having read Worcester CC Electoral Review submission, we agree with the recommendation of retaining the number of existing Councillors, along with the justification therein. However, we are very concerned at the proposal that County Councillor's areas may be changed.

We live in Dormston and have lost an excellent District Councillor in Rob Adams, due to retirement, his role being subsequently absorbed by County Councillor Linda Robinson.

Over a number of years, Linda has provided an excellent and very proactive service to Kington & Dormston residents, either at a personal level, or via the Parish Council. She brings a wealth of experience, objectivity and as importantly, a very healthy dose of common sense, sadly lacking in many quarters of society.

Whilst accepting that things change, we think one thing that is often overlooked, is the experience gained over time with the needs of the community involved and particularly, the relationships built with residents and Parish Councils alike.

As an example, we note the heavy focus placed on the Environment, related access to countryside and Health & Wellbeing in Worcestershire's submission. Despite this, there is an application with Wychavon for a c300Ha solar industrial estate within unspoilt countryside, which totally undermines these aims.

Linda's experience with local PCs and an understanding of the numerous objections across 3 locally impacted PCs, will be critical in ensuring these proposals are viewed holistically, taking all factors into account. This experience, continuity and clear understanding of the history and issues involved, will be lost with a change in County Councillor.

We trust these views will be positively considered, in ensuring that Dormston remains within the existing County boundary.
