To Whom It May Concern:

Please see below my comments on the current boundary review proposal in Sunderland.

It is important that Barnes Park is not split between two wards and that a clear, distinctive boundary separates Tunstall and Humbledon from Barnes and Thornhill. This should be the centre of Ettrick Grove and Durham Road which are distinctive and easy to identify. The Lib Dem proposal to use the back of people's properties as the boundary would be too confusing - if I live there and I have rats in my garden from the park, which councillor do I contact? The ones for the park or the ones for my ward? It is ridiculous that a rear garden fence should be a ward boundary. The Tunstall and Humbledon Ward makes good sense but the Sainsbury's site should not be split between two wards. Hollycarrside equally needs to be within a single ward and, given this faces onto Grangetown but is separated from Ryhope by a fairly large green space, it makes more sense to put all of it into Grangetown Ward (most of it is already in the proposed Grangetown Ward anyway).
