Hi

The proposal to run a boundary through the middle of Barnes Park is unacceptable to me and would cause substantial local governance issues.

There needs to be a clear dividing line between Barnes and Thornhill and Tunstall and Humbledon and the best way to do this with minimal impact on elector numbers is to use Ettrick Grove and Durham Road as the boundary. Residents living in houses that back onto the park should be in the same ward as the park because their houses a) obscure what would be the boundary, making it hard to identify and b) are impacted by issues in the park.

I also endorse the proposals to include the Sainsbury's supermarket site in a single ward. Previously the lighting across the entire supermarket estate went down and this required a Council response; this was best achieved by having the entire site within a single ward, so only one set of councillors had to deal with the store manager.
