My comments relate to the change proposed by the Boundary Commission for Stroud District that the Thrupp/Brimscombe ward (north of A419) should be split from Chalford & Minchinhampton and joined up to Bisley & Painswick instead. As a local resident and also Clerk to Brimscombe and Thrupp Parish Council I feel that the communities along the Chalford valley and sides have a lot in common, and it makes more sense for them to be combined as a county division than splitting off Thrupp to join more distant Bisley/Painswick communities. There is a clear link between the Parishes in terms of the main route into Stroud (A419) which links up these communities and means that they share many amenities and related issues.
